



JADT 2014: Call for Papers

Dear Colleagues,

We are glad to announce the call for papers of JADT 2014, the 12th International Conference on the Statistical Analysis of Textual Data, which will be held in Paris (France), from 3 to 6 June 2014 (organised by ERTIM (Inalco), SYLED (Université Sorbonne nouvelle Paris 3)).

This biennial conference, which has constantly been gaining importance since it was first held in Barcelona (1990), is open to all scholars and researchers working in the field of textual data analysis; ranging from lexicography to the analysis of political discourse, from information retrieval to marketing research, from computational linguistics to sociolinguistics, from text mining to content analysis. After the success of the previous meetings (<http://lexicometrica.univ-paris3.fr/jadt/index.htm>), the three-day conference in Paris will continue to offer a workshop-style forum through technical paper sessions, invited talks, and panel discussions.

Title and pre-submission

Participants interested in presenting a paper for either an oral or poster presentation, should submit title and abstract (maximum 20 lines) by October 1st, 2013.

Papers

The Authors should submit the full paper **by November 24, 2013**. The papers will be peer reviewed. The full text of the communication should be 12 pages at the most, including references. Authors will be notified of the Scientific Committee's decisions on the acceptance of their proposal and on the presentation format (oral communication or poster) **by February 1st, 2014**.

Final Papers (for Proceedings publication)

The Authors are invited to submit the final accepted version of paper (12 pages) of their contribution **by March 1st, 2014**, using the same paper's submission procedure. The final paper will be subject to a final re-reading.
